



# PRODUCT CARE AND MAINTENANCE

## CAST ALUMINIUM

Cast aluminum is incredibly durable but relatively light weight. Most of our cast products are die cast, which makes them even stronger.

Cast is rust resistant but does still require some maintenance.

You should clean your setting with mild soapy water on a regular basis.

## STONE

The timeless beauty of natural stone has made this material a favourite choice for our stone tables. All tables will differ slightly, so please enjoy your table for what it is, a one-off work of art. To maintain the finish, coasters should be used to avoid spills, as stone is a porous product. We do seal our tables with Aqua-Seal sealers, but this will not protect them from acid-based items such as red wine, coffee, salad dressings etc.

The tables should be cleaned with ph neutral cleaners.

All our tables come with covers and it is recommended that these are used when not using the table.

## STEEL

Our steel range is galvanised to give it the highest possible resistance against rust.

We do recommend cleaning with ph neutral cleaners on a regular basis to keep your goods looking as good as new.

## WICKER

All our wicker products have been designed and made to very high standards.

The wicker is a P.E. synthetic product that has UV stabilisers in it to help protect it from harsh sunlight.

We recommend cleaning on a regular basis with ph neutral cleaners.

## RECYCLED TEAK

Our teak tables have been made and designed to very high standards but recycled timber does have various imperfections which add to the beauty and individuality of the table.

Teak, over time, will go a sliver grey colour, but if you want to maintain its original look, the use of teak oil is highly recommended.

## MARINE LEATHER / PU LEATHER

Our Rita chairs have marine leather cushions which are not vinyl.

The marine leather has a soft feel and has been specially treated for the outdoors.

It is water, UV, mould and mildew resistant and will also resist light scratching.

If anything acidic like coffee, red wine etc is spilled on the chairs, please clean straight away to stop any staining occurring

For cleaning we recommend a wet rag and soapy water or ph neutral cleaners
